Winter wet summer dry

During the rainy season water accumulates in these locations and can occasionally remain standing for a day or two. The soil can remain saturated for extended periods of time. Once the rains stop the soil dries remaining parched until the fall rains.

Seasonal standing water/ long periods of water saturation

These soils are consistently very moist with standing water for over a week during the rainy season. During very long drought it can dry out completely.

Very Moist but no standing water

These soils are often drainages where winter rains gather and are absorbed into the ground. Once the rains end they will shortly dry out. Many plants tolerating these conditions will need some watering during drought.
